# Why PCDH?

- Provides a vehicle to close the loop on care when a patient is seen outside their normal care area.
- Enables nationwide access to patient information that follows the patient and facilitates better treatment.
- Links existing communities of trust established by health information exchanges.
- Preserves local governance.
- Protects local stakeholders.

# What is PCDH?

- The only national network that pushes ADTs based on zip codes between trusted networks.
- HIEs route ADTs with out of market zip codes to a regional hub that routes to the HIE/s covering these zip codes.
- HIEs incorporate inbound ADTs into their products and services per their data governance rules.
- PCDH routes 40M+ out of market ADTs annually.
- Four regional hubs will consolidate to two hubs (Velatura and IHIE).

# Status + Future Opportunities

1. Should the HIE community leverage the interoperability work it has done via PCDH to build a data business?
2. Is there a market for the national connectivity beyond the federal govt and national payers?
3. What is the appetite for current participants to turn PCDH into something more like a national network?
4. Would HIE's be willing to come together and fund an initiative?
5. Are there just too many data governance issues that most regions won't be able to agree to?
